1 Commit

Maintain net zero carbon emissions across global operations from 2015 onwards, supported by commitments to energy use reduction and 100% renewable electricity supply.

2 Disclose

Report global energy use and Scope 1 and 2 greenhouse gas emissions annually through the CDP Climate Change disclosure and company sustainability report.

3 Act

Achieve carbon neutrality through the Carbon Reduction Framework, which prioritises energy reduction initiatives across Goldman Sachs facilities and enables the procurement of renewable electricity and high-quality certified carbon offsets.

4 Verify

Undergo independent third-party verification of global energy and greenhouse gas emissions data per the GHG Protocol annually and aim to certify 70% of building footprint through LEED or equivalent green building standards.

5 Advocate

Support sustainable growth by harnessing capital to scale innovative business models, integrating ESG data and perspectives into investment research, and partnering to invest in initiatives that advance sustainable development. Deploy a sustainable procurement framework across full supply chain.
